By the end of this week long course, participants will be able to state the major functions of the **cardiovascular**, **nervous**, **digestive and muscular systems**, as well as gain valuable insight into working within the healthcare system.

Our 5,000 sq.ft. facility is equipped with a collection of plastinated specimens sourced from the creators of **BodyWorlds**, a full cadaver lab using proprietary softembalmed tissue, as well as conference, kitchen and lounge spaces.
